As the weather is getting warmer, please can you:

- talk to your child about the importance of sun protection at home,
- send your child to school with a wide brimmed hat or legionnaire style hat and sunglasses,

- put sun cream on your child before they come to school in the morning, - supply your child with their personal bottle of sun cream, factor 15+, to bring and leave in school with their name on the bottle.
