## **EARLY EDUCATION – 10 HOURS**

If your child's 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday falls between September 1<sup>st</sup> and December 31<sup>st</sup> 2024 they are eligible to attend the Rising 3's at school for the Spring and Summer terms 2025.

If your child's 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday falls between January 1<sup>st</sup> and March 31<sup>st</sup> 2025 they are eligible to attend for the Summer term 2025.

To make an application for the 10 hours you need to visit Denbighshire County Council website and complete the online form. You also need to bring your child's birth certificate and proof of address to the school. If you have any questions, please contact the school.
