SECONDARY ADMISSION

Parents of year 6 pupils can apply for secondary September 2025 admissions through Denbighshire County Council website. **The closing date is 4**th **November 2024.**

NURSERY & RECEPTION ADMISSION

Nursery and Reception applications for September 2025 admissions open from this **Monday 23**rd **September** through Denbighshire County Council website.

The closing date for Reception applications is 18^{th} November 2024 – **those** who have children in our current nursery class will need to apply now for Reception.

The closing date for Nursery applications is 17th February 2025.

EARLY EDUCATION – 10 HOURS

If your child's 3rd birthday falls between September 1st and December 31st 2024 they are eligible to attend the Rising 3's at school for the Spring and Summer terms 2025.

If your child's 3rd birthday falls between January 1st and March 31st 2025 they are eligible to attend for the Summer term 2025.

To make an application for the 10 hours you need to visit Denbighshire County Council website and complete the online form. You also need to upload your child's birth certificate and proof of address when completing the online form. If you have any questions, please contact the school.
